

# Buggy Rules

## Including Blue Flags



1. All buggy users **MUST** follow the signs for the course route for buggies, use the appropriate buggy paths and keep out of roped off areas and ground under repair at all times.
2. Buggies **MUST** be driven from cart paths at 90 degree to the ball at all times when crossing fairways and rough. The 90 degree rule.
3. Buggies **MUST NOT** be used by more than 2 people and never driven by anyone under 16 years of age.
4. Buggies **MUST NOT** under any circumstances be driven on to tees, bunker edges or within 20 metres of greens. Including Blue Flag users.
5. Buggies **MUST** remain on the buggy path on all Par 3's.
6. Players using buggies do not have preference over players who are walking.
7. No more than **2 buggies** must be used in each game regardless of the number of players.
8. In adverse weather buggies will be restricted to cart paths only.
9. 'Blue Flags' are only for personal use and any abuse of this privilege will result in 'Blue Flag' status being withdrawn. (Blue flags may have permission to use their buggies on days when the general use of buggies is prohibited).
10. All buggy users **MUST** adhere to these **Buggy Rules** and obey the Course Marshall's instructions. Any person failing to do so will immediately be required to leave the course.

Infringement of these rules may result in disciplinary action or the suspension of the blue flag
